

## HOW WILL EUROPEAN FARMERS BENEFIT?



Agri-food exports to Japan – € 5.7 bn (4th biggest market for EU agri exports in the world)

**85%** of EU agri-food products exported to Japan will be liberalised over time

**Slashed tariffs** = access for **50 500 t** of EU beef, virtually free trade access for EU pigmeat

TARIFF REMOVAL	BEFORE	AFTER
Wine & sparkling wine	15%	0% from day one
Alcoholic beverages (sherry, vermouth, cider) Pork	15% Complex import system + tariff (average 4.3%)	<b>0</b> % from day one Practically <b>free</b> access
Processed pork	8.5%	0%
<b>Hard cheese</b> (Parmigiano Reggiano, Gouda, Cheddar, etc.)	Up to 29.8%	0% after 15 years
<b>Soft and fresh cheese</b> (Mozzarella, Feta)	Up to 29.8%	Duty free quota equivalent to current EU exports
Beef	38.5%	Down to 9% over 15 years
